

Directional Greeter Volunteer Assignment

Thank you for volunteering to help with the Hike for the Homeless! Directional greeters are important in helping the hikers/participants find their way into the park and to our event area. We will have directional greeters stationed at intersections (not on the road; off to the side and wearing yellow vests) to enthusiastically welcome everyone to the event.

- **Please arrive at 8:00 a.m. to receive instructions, help put out the signs and get to your post. The shift will last until most of the crowd has arrived (about 9:45 to 10 a.m.)**
- When you arrive, you will check in at the volunteer registration area to get your assigned post, pick up any signs/balloons to put out, put on a yellow reflective safety vest and get any additional details.
- Please be energetic and warm in welcoming cars as they arrive for the Hike. Please also use extreme caution in ensuring you remain safely off the road and out of traffic. **Keeping yourself and others safe is very important.**
- **This year, we will have 3 posts.** We would like to have at least 2 volunteers at each of these intersections (These two intersections are stars with a yellow circle around them on the attached map.)
 - ❖ Intersection of Old Hickory Blvd and Vaughn Road
 - ❖ Intersection of Vaughn Road and the road leading up to picnic pavilions
 - ❖ Intersection at the event area where cars turn in to park
- **When you come back from your post, please bring any directional yellow yard signs along the road at your corner. Please disassemble signs and stack them by volunteer registration, out of the way. Under a table may be a good location.**
