

T-Shirt Volunteer Assignment

Thank you for volunteering to help with the Hike for the Homeless! There are 2 shifts for the T-shirt Tent. Please check your email to see what time for which you have been scheduled!

Shift #1: 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. (Set up the t-shirt area and work the table; please arrive early if you can!)

Shift #2: 10:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. (Work the table and clean up the area when the event ends)

- **When you arrive please check-in at the Volunteer Registration Table**, then report to the T-shirt Tent at your assigned start time.
- If you have the early shift, set up the tables and place the t-shirts out for ease in distribution. You can arrange the shirts by size and gender to make it easy. The t-shirt volunteer leads will instruct this process

2019 Hike T-Shirts:

- Hikers will come to the T-Shirt Tent to pick up their shirts.
- Hikers should have a ticket to give you in exchange for the t-shirt. Please ask their size (we have children's, women's and men's/ unisex sizes), take their ticket and give them their shirt. A team captain may pick up his/her whole team that is fine. **(Note: please give women's sizes to women, unless they request otherwise)**
- If a Hiker doesn't have a t-shirt ticket, but decides they want a t-shirt, please let them know that we are asking for donation of \$25 or more to receive a t-shirt. Encourage them to go to the registration area to make the donation and get a ticket. If the registration area is closed, or they do not want to go back to that area, please take their cash or check or get instruction from the t-shirt tent lead to process a credit card. Checks should be made payable to Safe Haven. There will be a cash box at the t-shirt station along with donation envelopes. Please do not leave the cash box unattended. Let the volunteer leads handle the money and cash box. If they want to make the donation by credit card, they can do so on the ipad or using the hike4homeless.org link on their phone.

2019 Dog Bandanas (NEW FOR 2019- these will be at the DOG TENT, not T-SHIRT TENT)

- Dog bandanas are free to hikers until they run out. There are small and large sizes.

2018 Green T-shirts:

- There are some t-shirts left over from past years. These are available for a \$5 donation. Collect money and checks in the cash box. (check made payable to Safe Haven).

"Vintage T-shirts (varying colors):

- There are other shirts in varying colors (blue, light gray, dark gray, black, brown, white) that can be purchased for \$5. A \$5 donation lets the hiker have one shirt from every year available. We are trying to reduce inventory of "vintage" shirts. If someone wants 2 shirts of one color and none from another color, that is fine too.

End Family Homelessness Shirts (at the SAFE HAVEN INFO BOOTH)

- End Family Homelessness T-shirts are available for \$20. Payment can be made by cash, check or credit card. If using credit card, the person will need to make the donation on the ipad -- or on their phone with the correct link.

We abide by the "Hiker is always right" motto. People are typically honest. So if there is any question about whether a Hiker should get a shirt, trust the hiker. 😊
