### **Organizational Health – Finance:**

*Develops, oversees, and approves organization's budgets, financial reports, financial policy, and audits.*

### **Community Influence - Marketing / PR:**

*Works to develop marketing strategies, resources, and meet marketing/PR needs of the organization. Provides critical advice to staff around crisis communications and related issues.*

### **Program Excellence - Property Management:**

*Provides leadership around property management (repairs, costs, changes, long range planning) and assures the organization's properties (shelter and transitional) are well maintained. This group also and makes recommendations around the acquisition and divestment of current and future properties to insure we have adequate temporary housing and shelter to server our clients.*

### **Organizational Health - Board Development/Board Engagement:**

*Works with the full board, advisory council, emeritus board to identify, cultivate, and recruit new board members and leadership. Also provides development opportunities for the board (training, strategic planning, social).*

### **Community Influence – Advocacy:**

*To bring relevant topics to the attention of the staff and board and consider their impact, to educate staff and board on issues that have an impact on family homelessness, to consider taking a point of view and having a larger community footprint and impact, and to turn donors, volunteers, and community supporters into advocates for the mission. This group will also meet with those of influence whose impact affects our mission and families experiencing homelessness.*

### **Housing Task Force:**

*The Housing Impact Team consults with housing staff on affordable housing matters and options while also creating a new development stream to raise unrestricted housing revenue.*



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Volunteer Agreement

- I will commit to 6-8 hours per month of dedicated time (Impact meetings, YPC meetings, administrative work etc.) over a 2-year board term.
