

## **ANNUAL MEETING GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1) Knowing that affordable housing in Nashville is an issue, how would you expand housing opportunities for our clients? Think about the expansion of landlord partnerships, more permanent supportive housing structures, etc.
- 2) What could we do to encourage individuals in our program to both get and keep a job? Knowing that child care and transportation are some of the biggest barriers for our families with employment, what ideas do you have to address those matters?
- 3) If you had to raise \$1 million dollars for Safe Haven in the next year, how would you do it? Assume for purposes of this question that you cannot utilize government grants for the question.
- 4) If you had a \$1 million to spend on Safe Haven programs (children, employment, education, housing, etc.), how would you spend it?
- 5) Knowing that all of our families are different, what do you think are the basic goals that all our families should obtain before they leave our program?
- 6) Nashville is facing a crisis when it comes to families experiencing homelessness. If you could give the Mayor three ideas about how to address the crisis, what would they be? Remember that you are serving as an advocate for families experiencing homelessness.
- 7) How do we increase Board and Council engagement? How do we increase collaboration across the Board, Advisory Board, and YPC to helping Safe Haven achieve their goals?
