

Children's Activities Volunteers

Thank you for volunteering to help with the Hike for Safe Haven! Please arrive at your shift start time (8:00a.m. or 10:30a.m) **When you arrive, check in at the Volunteer Registration table, and then proceed to your assigned area.**

During the event:

- Assist with keeping youth at the event engaged and safe in the children's area.
- Check on volunteers and staff with each children's activity to see if they need anything- bottled water, lunch, etc.
- Encourage families to visit Registration to get binoculars and Scavenger Hunt sheets for their kids.
- Tell families about the various activities their kids can participate in!
 - Rock wall
 - Obstacle Course
 - Face painting
 - Braids/tattoos
 - Mathnasium
 - Frist Art Activity
 - Visiting the princesses and heroes
 - Balloons
 - Giant yard games (cornhole, jenga, connect four)
 - Global Education Center drums

You will be assigned to a particular booth or activity for the duration of your shift. Some roles may involve assisting with managing lines for activities, leading an activity, or monitoring the children's area overall to ensure wellness of all participating.

Clean up:

- When the event begins to wind down, assist children's activities staff and volunteers with cleaning up. Throw away tablecloths and any trash you see.

Leave the table and chairs where they are, as they will be picked up by the rental company.
